

The Pasty Cup 25th – 26th May 2013

Notice of Race

- Racing will take place as per IKA/ISAF rules. Latest rules can be found at <http://www.internationalkiteboarding.org/>
- IKA Fleet is racing for the Pasty Cup and is for registered equipment as per IKA rules. Cash prize fund for top 3 with additional product prizes.
- Open Fleet is for boards 60cm & under with great prizes.
- You **must** be a member of the BKSA or other IKA National association & hold 3rd party insurance.

Start procedure

IKA fleet will start as per IKA rules. Open fleet will start 1 min after IKA fleet and **must** stay behind the finish line during the last minute before IKA fleet start.

Start line open – National Marine Aquarium Flag up

Red flag up – IKA 5 min

Red down, Yellow up – IKA 4 min

Yellow down – IKA 1 min (Open must stay behind finish line)

Green up – IKA Start, Open 1 min

Green down, BKSA UP – Open start

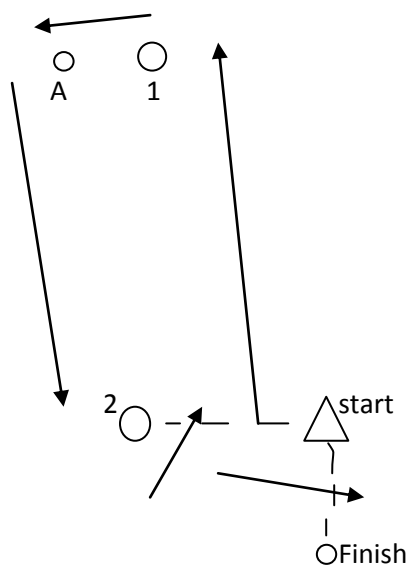
Finish line will stay open for 15 mins after 1st finisher when the BKSA flag will come down.

Courses

Courses will be windward/leeward course using large buoys with a smaller spreader mark (A) & displayed on the committee boat. Courses and mark type will be detailed at briefing.

The aim of the courses detailed below, are to ensure both fleets take roughly the same time.

Likely use of courses- Course A= small fleet. Course B = windy. Course C= light wind.



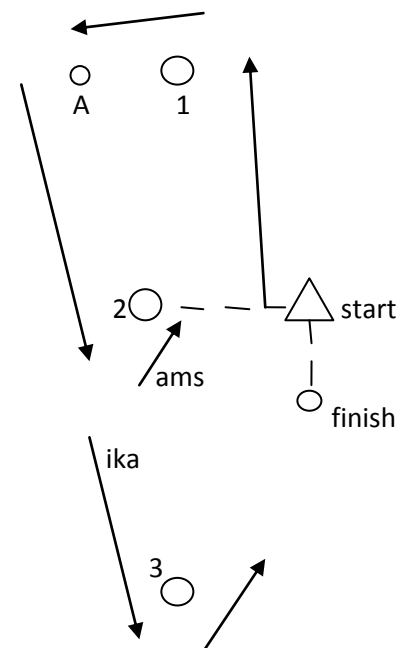
Course A

Start-1-A-2-1-A-2-Finish

Course C

Same as Course B except

IKA – Start-1-A-3-1-A-3-1-A-2-Finish



Course B

Open – Start-1-A-2-1-A-2-Finish

IKA – Start-1-A-3-1-A-2-Finish

Tally system

- You must wear your numbered race vest at all time while on the water.
- Vests must be collected at registration each day.
- You **must** hand your vest back in to race marshal within 1 hour after the last finisher of the last race. Failure to do so within the time will result in being disqualified.
- If you retire and return to the beach you must inform the race marshal.

Protests

Any protests must be logged within 1 hour of the finish of the session which the incident occurred. i.e a protest in the morning races must be lodged during the break.

Protest forms will be with the race marshal at the race office.

Any protests will be considered by the race committee and any hearings will be posted on the notice board within 1 hour of the protest being lodged.

Briefing

It is compulsory to attend the riders briefing both days.
